



Opinion Changes: Before and After Deliberations split by 'old' and 'new'

Document presents percentage breakdowns for statistically significant questions when comparing “Before Deliberation” attitudes and “After Deliberation” attitudes. Please note that all table items are percentages of total valid responses.
