2. The results presented are from a follow-up survey from the delegates of America in One Room, a national Deliberative Poll that was conducted in September 2019. The follow-up data was collected Sept 25 to Oct 5, 2020 by NORC at the University of Chicago. For this follow-up, 463 of the 523 delegates responded. Of the control group, 710 of the 844 responded.
